What is Birdies for Charity?

Birdies for Charity is an exciting way to stretch your donation dollars to the charity of your choice. All donations are matched by **15%**. Over **\$725,000** has been raised and distributed to participating charities.



How to Donate

Complete the Official Pledge Form. Similar to a walka-thon, pledge one cent or more per birdie scored by PGA TOUR players during the competitive rounds of the AT&T Pebble Beach National Pro-Am, February 9-12, 2012. For example, if you pledge one cent (.01) and 2000 birdies are scored, you would owe \$20. Monterey Peninsula Foundation (MPF) will invoice you for the amount you owe. **OR**, if you prefer, you can make a flat donation with a check made payable to MPF. In addition, online donations are accepted at **attpbgolf.com**.

15% Match

MPF will provide an additional 15% match to all donations made through Birdies for Charity. The charity will actually receive **115%** of funds collected.
