Recipe of the Month

Escalloped Pineapple submitted by Tamara Schwartz

Ingredients:

* 9 slices of white sandwich bread cut into 1-inch cubes. (about 5-6 cups)
* 3 eggs
* ½ cup milk
* I can (1lb 4oz) DOLE crushed pineapple, drained
* 1 ½ cups sugar
* ½ cup butter

Directions:

1. Place bread cubes in a 2.5 qt. buttered casserole dish.

2. Beat eggs-add milk, pineapple and sugar. Beat well.

3. Pour over bread cubes and lightly toss.

4. Cut remaining ½ cup butter into chunks and stick down into bread mixture all over.

5. Bake uncovered @ 350 degrees for 40-45- min. or until golden brown and puffy.

6. Remove from oven, let sit for 5 minutes and lightly toss.


